

# California Creativity Association Digital Privacy Policy

## Purpose of the policy

California Creativity, DBA California Destination Imagination (CalDI), collects, records, maintains, uses, and transmits personally identifiable information (PII) relating to CalDI-associated individuals. CalDI is committed to protecting PII against inappropriate access or use. The website <http://www.californiacreativity.org> or its alias <http://www.caldi.org> and the registration site <http://www.register.caldi.org> are owned and operated by CalDI. Our intention is to facilitate good communication among volunteers in the CalDI program and register teams in an easy, streamlined manner while protecting the privacy of all individuals using the sites.

## Policy statement

The personally identifiable information (PII) collected at any CalDI operated web site, such as names and contact information, will not be sold or otherwise provided to any other organization. PII will be protected in our systems and operations using secure design technologies and practices.

## Definitions

**Affiliate Director (AD):** Person in charge of administering the Destination Imagination (DI) Program in California.

**Personally identifiable information (PII):** Any digital information recorded on any CalDI web server, which when used alone or with other relevant data can identify an individual or identify an individual in context.

**Destination Imagination, Inc. (DII):** The organization with which CalDI is affiliated. DII administers the program known as Destination Imagination.

## Detailed policy statement

### Information Collected Only for CalDI

CalDI recognizes that visitors to our web sites may be concerned about the information that they provide to us and how we treat that information. CalDI is committed to honoring its participants' privacy. The PII collected at both web sites, such as names and contact information, will not be sold or otherwise provided to any other organization. Aggregate information, such as average team sizes or number of volunteers, may be shared with other affiliated, not-for-profit organizations, such as DII.

Many links to third-party web sites existing outside of CalDI may be provided. Because CalDI does not and cannot control the content or functionality of these web sites, we encourage you to review the privacy policies posted on these third-party web sites. <https://register.caldi.org/> to a third-party web site does not indicate an affiliation with the web site or an endorsement of its viewpoint(s) or mission(s).

With that said, CalDI cannot fully guarantee that the system will neither be compromised nor fail in any way that puts data at risk.
