## **Appraiser Requirements (Excerpt from Appraiser Policy & Procedures p 2 v 2.0)**

### Team Responsibilities

1. All Teams participating in CalDI Regional Tournaments must provide Appraisers and Officials according to Regional Guidelines in order to compete in the Regional Tournament.
2. Teams advancing to the Affiliate Tournament must provide one Certified Appraiser\* and at least one Official.
3. Team Managers registered in the CalDI Registration System will submit the name and contact information of a person who has agreed to represent their team as an Appraiser and work at one or more Tournaments during the DI program year. The Team Manager will ensure the designated Appraiser is registered in the CalDI Registration System as a Team Appraiser for the team's Team Number before the Region's Registration Close Date.
4. All Appraisers must attend Regional Training. Being trained and designated as such in the CalDI Registration System qualifies the Appraiser to work at a Regional Tournament.
5. Only Certified Appraisers are eligible to serve as a Team's Appraiser at the Affiliate Tournament.
6. Teams advancing to the Affiliate Tournament must complete their team's Registration for the Affiliate Tournament within one week after their Regional Tournament. This includes Team appraiser accepting role and official accepting role.

**If a Team does not provide a Certified Appraiser and an Official who have accepted their roles and registered as such for the Affiliate Tournament in the CalDI Registration System by the 1-week deadline, the Team will be allowed to participate (showcase only) in the Affiliate Tournament. These teams will not receive Placement and will not be permitted to advance to the Global Finals Tournament. Team provided Certified Appraisers and Officials must complete their assigned roles and responsibilities at the Affiliate Tournament in order for the teams they represent to receive Placement and eligibility to advance to the Global Finals Tournament.**

\* **Certified Appraiser:** A Trained Appraiser who has appraised at a Regional Tournament during the current program year, has fulfilled the Appraiser role and responsibilities satisfactorily at a Regional Tournament, and has been designated by RCMs and/or ACMs in the CalDI Registration System as "Trained, Experienced and Eligible for Reappointment." Only Certified Appraisers are qualified to appraise at the Affiliate Tournament.
