**Destination ImagiNation®**

**2006 Affiliate Competition – Entry and Advanced Levels**  
**ALL ABOARD!**

**Challenge:** Your **TASK** is to retrieve food items.

**Time:** You will have up to 4 minutes to use your **IMAGINATION** to build one or more devices to help you retrieve food items and to practice retrieving them. You will then have up to 3 minutes to retrieve food items for score.

**Set-up:** In the middle of the room is a taped area that represents a life raft. Your team will be floating on the life raft. The area outside of the tape represents the ocean. There are many food items floating in the water. You may use the materials inside the life raft to retrieve the food items.

**Procedure:** You and your teammates are floating on a life raft and must get food in order to survive. You are to use the materials that you find in the life raft to retrieve the food items and bring them into the life raft.

•**Part One** (4 minutes): Create one or more devices to help you retrieve food items. When using the device(s) to retrieve food items, no part of a team member's body may cross any of the taped lines. You may practice retrieving items during Part One. At the end of Part One, all of the food items will be returned to their original positions.

•**Part Two** (3 minutes): Retrieve food items for score. Each food item contains a number that tells you how many points the team will receive if that food item is retrieved. All-aboard!

**Materials:**

1 Sheet of Newspaper	1 Pizza Box	1 Paper Cup	5 Paper Clips
2 Yardsticks (Metersticks)	1 Pair of Tongs	1 Piece of Foil	5 Mailing Labels
3 Chenille Sticks (Pipe Cleaners)	2 Plastic Spoons	6 Rubber Bands	6 ft (180 cm) of Rope

The yardsticks (metersticks), pair of tongs, rope and food items may NOT be damaged and may NOT have the mailing labels attached to them.

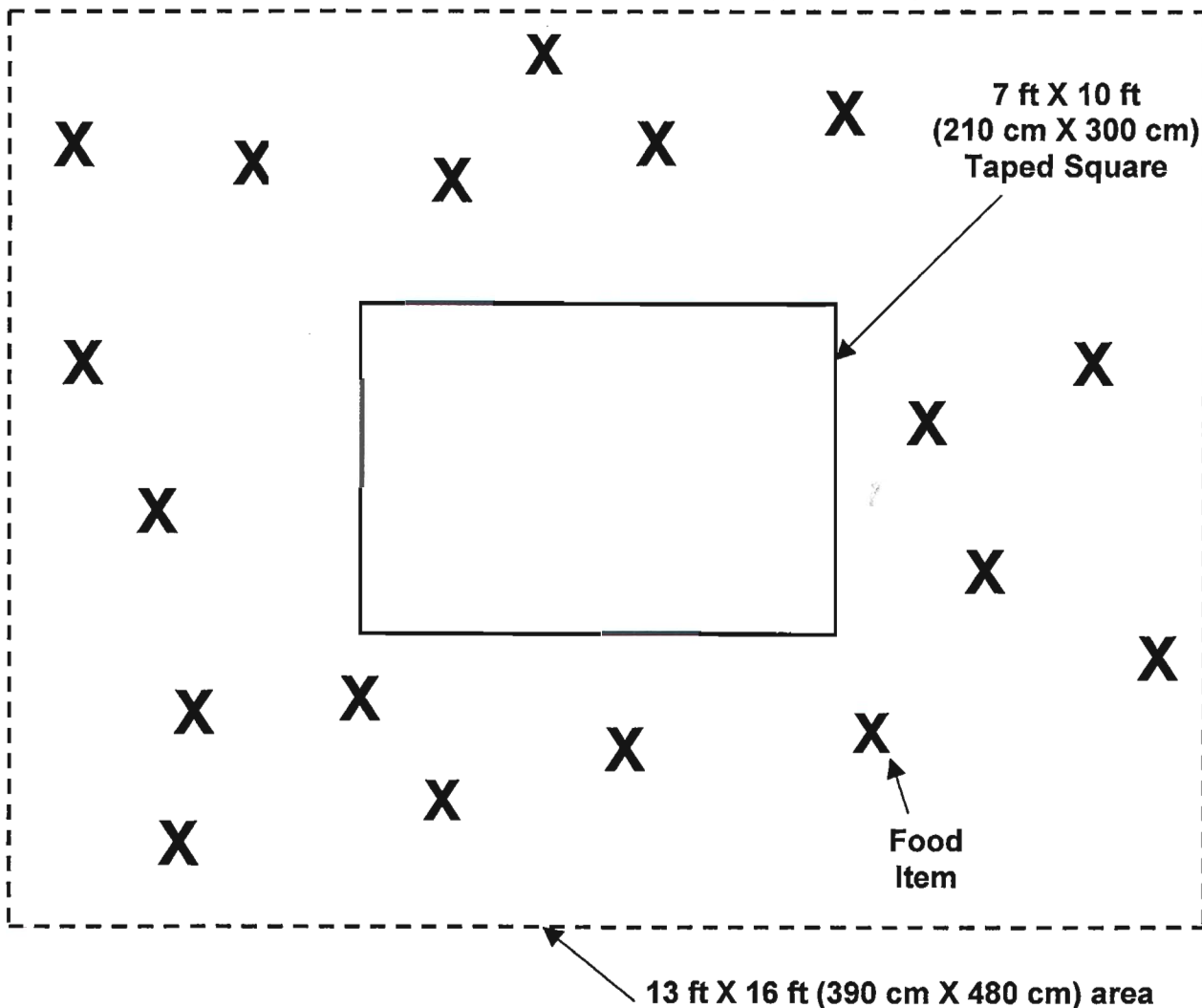
**Scoring:** You will receive

- A. Variable points (60 points maximum) for each object you retrieve and bring aboard the life raft in Part Two.
- B. Up to 20 points for how creatively you use the materials.
- C. Up to 20 points for how well your team works together.

Following the Tournament, all copies of this Challenge must be collected and destroyed.

### For Appraisers Only:

1. The set-up consists of a 7 ft X 10 ft (210 cm X 300 cm) taped area in the middle of the room. The materials are on the floor within the taped area. Around the taped rectangle are 16 food items within a 13 ft X 16 ft (210 cm X 480 cm) area. The location of each of the food items is marked with a piece of tape.



2. Possible food items are listed below. Each food item has a 2, 3, 4 or 5 written on it. Food items with the higher numbers are to be placed farther from the taped rectangle.

3. If a part of a team member's body crosses the taped line in Part Two, the team member should be warned. If such crossing results in an item being retrieved, that item should not receive score. If such crossing results in an item being moved, the item should be returned to its original taped position by one of the Appraisers.

# ALL ABOARD!
