### Destination ImagiNation® Instant Challenge 2005 Regional Competition - Entry Level

### AROUND THE HOUSE

Challenge: Your TASK is to think of a chore around the house and to invent a gadget that could make that chore easier. Your team then will present a PERFORMANCE in which you show how your gadget would make doing the chore easier.

Time: You will have up to 5 minutes to use your IMAGINATION to think of the chore, invent your gadget and plan your PERFORMANCE, and up to 2 minutes to present your PERFORMANCE to the Appraisers.

The Scene: Sometimes how we do a chore is not the best, safest, quickest, or most convenient way to do it. Your team is to pick one chore around the house that seems more difficult than it should be, and invent a gadget that would make that chore easier.

- •Part One (5 minutes): Think of a chore around the house and use the materials on the table to invent a gadget that would make that chore easier. You should write down the name of the chore on the piece of paper and give it to the Appraisers at the end of Part One.
- •Part Two (2 minutes): Present a PERFORMANCE in which you show the Appraisers how your gadget works and how it would make doing the chore easier.

#### Materials:

5 Cotton Buds 3 Paper Plates 1 Sponge 4 feet (120 cm) of Yarn 3 Index Cards 1 Sheet of Newspaper 1 Piece of Foil 4 Mailing Labels 1 Small Paint Brush 1 Shoe 1 Mug 1 Scarf

1 Plunger

The brush, shoe, mug, scarf and plunger may NOT be damaged and may NOT have the mailing labels attached to them. A piece of paper and a pencil also will be available for your team to use as you plan and present your PERFORMANCE.

Scoring: You will receive

- A. 10 points if you show how the gadget works during your PERFORMANCE.
- B. Up to 20 points for how creatively you use the materials to create the gadget.
- C. Up to 20 points for how creatively the gadget helps make the chore easier.
- D. Up to 30 points for the creativity of your PERFORMANCE.
- E. Up to 20 points for how well your team works together.
