2004 IC PlayDay - Entry/Advanced Level

RETRIEVAL

Challenge: Your **TASK** is to move three objects beyond foul lines and retrieve them.

Time: You will have up to 4 minutes to use your **IMAGINATION** to develop your solution and practice and up to 2 minutes to place and retrieve objects for score.

Set-up: There are three taped lines in the floor, each labeled with the name of the item to be retrieved from that line. On a table are materials for your team to use for retrieving objects.

Procedure:

- Part One (4 minutes): Develop and practice your solution. During this time any materials may be used from any line.
- Part Two (2 minutes): Retrieve objects for score. Objects may be placed using materials or by hand. Only the materials provided may be used for object retrieval. During retrieval no part of a team member's body may cross over the taped line. If a team member crosses over the line while retrieving the attempt will start over. Retrievals may be attempted any number of times, however the **LAST** attempt will be scored. (FOR ADVANCED TEAMS ONLY, remove the word "completed" from the last sentence. An attempt will be considered placement of the object followed by contact with the materials.) Once an object has been used in a retrieval from one line, it may not be used in a retrieval from any other line. Each object must be retrieved to its line to be counted for score.

1 Cup	3 Paper Clips	48" Yarn
1 Sheet Paper	5 Mailing Labels	24" String

The following materials may not be altered:

Scoring: You will receive

- 5 points (15 points maximum) for each object retrieved.
- 2 points (40 points maximum) for each foot (12 inches) in distance the objects were retrieved from.
- Up to 25 points for creativity of solutions, whether they are successful or not.
- Up to 20 points for how well your team works together.

Instant Challenge

● **For Appraisers only:**

- 1) Three lines have been taped on the floor, and marked with the item to be retrieved to that line. Items retrieved to lines other than their own may not be counted for score.
- 2) Be sure to mark the distance of retrieval for each attempt that is made for each object, and realize that for entry level teams the last completed attempt will be scored. **FOR ADVANCED TEAMS ONLY** the last attempt will be scored, and an attempt is considered placement of the object followed by contact with any of the materials.
- 3) Note that the challenge is not clear on whether the materials can remain in contact with the objects while they are placed and before a retrieval is attempted. It is up to you as facilitators to decide what you would like to see, but I would recommend that **ADVANCED TEAMS ONLY** be told that the materials may not remain in contact with the object between placement and retrieval.

- Retrievals may be attempted any number of times, however the **LAST** attempt will be scored. (FOR ADVANCED TEAMS ONLY, remove the word "completed" from the last sentence. An attempt will be considered placement of the object followed by contact with the materials.)
- Once an object has been used in a retrieval from one line, it may not be used in a retrieval from any other line.
- Each object must be retrieved to its line to be counted for score.

Scoring: You will receive

- A. 5 points (15 points maximum) for each object retrieved.
- B. 2 points (40 points maximum) for each foot (12 inches) in distance the objects were retrieved from.
- C. Up to 25 points for creativity of solutions, whether they are successful or not.
- D. Up to 20 points for how well your team works together.
