

# SOLUTION STATION

To support your DI Team in the creation of their solution, without interfering, consider making a Solution Station chart. The chart serves as an organized “To Do” List for the team. The chart can be easily made with poster board and post-it notes.

**Directions:** Have each team member write their name at the top of a ½ sheet of paper, and under it have them write their 3 best strengths that help the team. Every time the team identifies something they need to do to complete their solution, have them write it on a post-it note, and stick it under the proper person’s name. Other team members can help that person, but they are responsible for making sure this gets done. Tasks can be easily reassigned to spread the work evenly around. Remove the note when the task is completed.
