### *Instant Challenge*

# WHAT'S HAPPENING?

**Challenge:** Depict and identify 3 historical events from the past.

**Time:** You will have up to 4 minutes to use your IMAGINATION to choose 2 teammates to leave the room and for the other teammates to determine how to depict 3 historical events from the past. You will then have up to 2 minutes to portray these events to the Appraisers and the 2 teammates, and up to 1 minute for the 2 teammates to identify what events you have depicted.

### **The Scene:**

- Part 1 (4 minutes): Two members of your team will be transported back in time to 3 historical events.
  - You must first choose 2 team members, who will leave the room accompanied by one of the Appraisers.
  - The remaining members of your team must choose 3 historical events and decide how you can depict those events without using language (either written or spoken). The events must happen in 3 different time periods. Prior to your teammates reentering the room, you must write down on a sheet of paper the 3 events that you will be depicting.
- Part 2 (2 minutes): Your teammates will return and you will have 2 minutes to depict the 3 historical events. Your presentation must make it clear that 3 separate events are being depicted.
- Part 3 (1 minutes): Your teammates will try to identify the 3 historical events and give the reasoning for their choices.

**Items to Use in Your Presentation:** You will be given a piece of paper and pencil to write down the 3 historical events your team is depicting.

**Scoring:** You will receive up to

- 20 points each (60 points total) for the creativity of how you depict each event.
- 5 points each (15 points total) for your teammates identification of the events and for the reasoning behind their choices.
- 25 points for how well your team works together.
